Why Choose Multimedia?

- Opportunities to increase engagement by shifting modalities.
- Video, audio: Establish your presence.
- H5P: Offer formative feedback.
- It can also help you reframe content for yourself, too!

When to Choose Multimedia

- Weekly videoblogs / podcasts to connect with students.
- Audio / video feedback.
- Underscore key points (rather than a three-hour lecture, use video to reinforce critical concepts).
- To offer formative feedback or opportunities for practice (H5P).

Things to Keep in Mind

- Survey students to know in advance about access needs.
- Attention to video caps out at around 5-6 minutes.
- Captioning video / offering audio transcription boosts accessibility.
- Remember that when we teach online, we can be curators of the open web -- you don't need to create all the content yourself!
